## OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

### TEAM CAPTAIN: PLEASE RETAIN FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- 1) The Panama City Open Tournament is conducted under the authority of and certified by the United States Bowling Congress and all applicable USBC Rules will govern this tournament. [The tournament is open to all Panama City USBC sanctioned members.](#)
- 2) All participants must be 18 years of age or older at time of competition. Bowlers must provide proof of membership upon checking in. If current membership cannot be verified, a USBC Associate membership card must be purchased at the tournament site.
- 3) Entering Average:
  - A. Highest 2024-25 USBC average (winter or summer) of 21 or more games;
  - B. If NO 2024-25 USBC average (winter or summer), use highest current season USBC average as of 1 Jan 2026;
  - C. Bowlers with none of the above averages must bowl scratch

It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.

Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the re-rate entry fee will be refunded. **IF A BOWLER HAS BEEN RERATED OR REFUSED A RERATE IN THE PAST 10 YEARS, IT MUST BE REPORTED AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.**

***USBC Rule 319 DOES APPLY. Averages as Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 2026 will be applied to the 10 Pin rule. All averages are subject to further verification by the Tournament Director.***

- 4) TOURNAMENT HANDICAP IS 90% OF 220.
- 5) All prize money will be returned 100%.
  - a) at the following ratios: 1 in 6 for team, doubles and singles and 1 in 10 for all events.
  - b) In the event of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. Equal awards will be given.
- 6) Plaques will be awarded to the winning team, doubles partners and singles in all divisions in both handicap and scratch. All entrants are automatically eligible for all events awards if they bowl team, doubles, and singles. To be eligible for the **cash** awards of the All Events an additional entry fee must accompany the entry form. Paid all events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all three events and the transfer is made by the tournament director prior to the time of the substitute's participation in any event.
- 7) Multiple participation is allowed in Team, Doubles and Singles, but not All-Events. Teams may not have more than 2 original bowlers on any additional team entry. Bowlers may participate as many times in D/S. You must change doubles partners to cash more than once. Cash only once in Singles. Scores bowled by an ineligible player will be disqualified. All Events standing will be determined by the bowler's first appearance in the team, doubles and singles events.
- 8) Members entered in the doubles event **MUST ALSO ENTER SINGLES** and members entered in singles **MUST ALSO ENTER DOUBLES** event.
- 9) After entries have been received and dates assigned by the Tournament Director, no fees shall be re-funded except for emergencies.
- 10) No changes will be made in the entrant's scheduled time except in case of an emergency and any change must be approved by the Tournament Director.
- 11) Individuals who are members of bowling organizations identified as "professional" are eligible for participation; however, not more than one professional bowler may compete on a four-person team or doubles team.
- 12) Team captains and substitutions must report to the tournament office at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

***The Tournament Director reserves the right to add additional shifts or extend the entry deadline as deemed necessary.***

**TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RE-RATE ANY ENTRANT PRIOR TO BOWLING. IF THE ENTRANT REFUSES THE RE-RATE, ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.**

***DRESS CODE: Preferred dress code is collared shirts with casual slacks. Shorts, skirts, and skorts must come within 4 inches of the knees. Jeans and Tee-Shirts in good taste will be acceptable as long as they are neat with no profane pictures and/or words. Pictures or words that could be considered controversial to other bowlers based on race, religion, politics or sex. Tournament management reserves the right to make all final decisions on dress code.***
